- Linen 28ct, 4¹/₂ inches square with zigzagged edge.
- -Perle 8 as well as 6 stranded cotton of the same colour or variegated 6 stranded cotton
- Quilt batting scraps to make up to A4 size (can be provided by Sue for \$1 if you order)
- Matching thread for cupcake, DMC498 for red cupcake.
- Sewing thread for lacing.
