REPORT on PUNT'E N'U Workshop - Pearl Stenhouse

Knotted Embroidery Workshop

Our tutor, Yvette introduced us to the history of Punt'e N'u (knotted stitch.) Traditionally Punt'e N'U was used on men's shirts, particularly the collars, cuffs, and yokes.

Yvette certainly has conquered the art of this beautiful knotted work. As with most tutors Yvette came laden with goodies, linen packs, banding, scissors, threads, pendant packs, and of course books she has written several including Hardanger, Mountmellick, Ukrainian and Portuguese to name a few.

I joined 11 women whose interest in the allusive needle and thread came together to conquer the art of Sardinian Knotted Embroidery.

With 9.00am starts and putting our watches back an hour each day (only kidding) still wanting more time.

Something is seriously wrong when 12 adult women can't count to 3 (some better than others) reverse stitching and undoing knots has taken on a whole new meaning. How wonderful to have a piece of embroidery finished before it is started, (as the border was worked before any knotted work was done)

This form of embroidery was a pleasure to work counting being the hardest, the art of doing the knots was in the tension. 28ct linen was used but still hard to find horizontal thread once mastered away we went.

Thank you Yvette for your patience and perseverance with your expert help all 12 finished the 2 days on a high.

Thank you also to all 11 ladies we had a lot of fun and laughter have gone home much wiser and full of enthusiasm and lighter wallets.

A must workshop for all in the future.
