Stitchers will need 28 count or whatever they have 14" X 8" and a long piece 20" x 3 1/2 " for around as pages. Own choice of colour.

Gay Eaton's Ukrainian book has been used for the pattern.

Sewing kit

Perle thread, mostly12, but depends on the count of the fabric.

DMC thread for writing.

Eventually you will need cardboard for the box and fabric to make the pin cushion and line the box.
