Kitset - \$6.00 - includes silk ribbon, background fabric stabilized and overlocked, netting, organza, nylon thread, variegated stranded cotton and picture/notes.



You will need:-Usual sewing kit including a chenille needle Stranded cottons in three or four greens, ecru, buttercup yellow and light tan Fabric marking pencil Embroidery frame approx. 6" size - optional Photo frame with 4" x 6" opening

Pearls Soup!

Several of you enjoyed Pearls soup at our last meeting and so she has kindly shared the recipe:

3 Tbsp oil
4 large parsnips peeled and diced
2 Pears cored, peeled and diced
3 Shallots or 1 Red onion diced,
a piece of ginger as long as your small finger grated,
1/2 tsp curry powder
1/2 tsp turmeric
1/2 tsp garam masala
1/2 stick lemongrass pounded
salt and pepper to taste
1ltr vegetable or chicken stock
Soften onion in oil add everything else but Pears and simmer till soft.
Add Pears and cook for 5 minutes.
Cool slightly then transfer to blender and process till smooth.
Enjoy.
